



## **INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROPOSED SLOPE PROTECTION PROJECT ALONG ARGONAUT HIGHWAY, SBFZ**

1. The Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority, Subic Bay Freeport Zone, through the Corporate Budget for the contract approved by the SBMA Governing board intends to apply the sum of Php 1.8 Million being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for *The Proposed Slope Protection Project Along Argonaut Highway, SBFZ*. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority now invites bids for the *Proposed Slope Protection Project along Argonaut Highway, SBFZ*. The work shall consist of providing 100mm. thk. Concrete Sprayed (Shotcrete) slope protection including gauge 10 (50mm. x 50mm.) welded wire mesh reinforcement, 16mm diameter bar dowels, 50mm. diameter PVC weepholes, necessary excavation, backfilling and disposal, permits and insurances and all other tools, equipments and incidentals to complete the works. Completion of the Works is required within ninety (90) calendar days. Bidders should have completed, within ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".
4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority, Subic Bay Freeport Zone and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of Php 8,000.
